This Senior Leader programme is for:

- established senior school leaders to help them develop and improve their leadership skills;
- senior leaders new in post to build their leadership skills through new experiences;
- established and experienced middle leaders keen to develop further or seek new challenges.

How does the programme work?

The programme is part of the National College Leadership Curriculum and consists of Essential modules and Elective modules.

Where will it be based?

We are hoping that all face-to-face days will be hosted in Brunei; however, this is subject to recruitment to a viable cohort size.

Each module has 50 hours of work: face-to-face; online, applied school-based tasks, collaborative learning groups. Participants undertake a longer in-school strategic task. All work is at M-level.			

How much does the programme cost?

We are offering NPQSL at £1,400 to FOBISIA schools. In addition those who apply from schools outside of England will also need to pay £440 for their final assessment.
