- Line management arrangements: processes and protocols and reporting procedures.

Participants will be provided with a toolkit of resources to enable them to:

- Plan an annual programme to enable then to have a half-termly oversight of the quality of standards within each / all areas of the subject / department / school;
- Present the evidence and evaluation judgements in specially-designed reporting formats;
- Use 'mind mapping' software as a mechanism for storing and interpreting your own evidence.
