FOBISIA TEACHERS' CONFERENCE

Dear Colleagues

Following a recommendation to the FOBISIA Heads, it has been decided to change the venue, though not the location, of the Teachers' Conference scheduled for October 16-18. The relatively high cost of the original conference venue and accommodation was thought to be a factor in the modest number of registrations that have been received to date.

The British International School, Phuket has offered to host the conference and also to provide accommodation (limited to 80 teachers) at a much lower price than the luxury hotels on the Island. The Conference Organising Committee has also sourced significantly lower hotel costs at accommodation (Boat Lagoon Resort Hotel) near to the school. By relocating the conference to the British International School Phuket, we are now able to significantly reduce venue overheads without impacting on the quality of the conference. It is our intention that more teachers will now be encouraged to attend.

The cost of the 'new look' conference hosted by BISP is 6,000THB. This includes refreshments, lunches, BBQ and a Gala function at a leading hotel (this will include entertainment and live music). Local transport costs are also included in the conference fee (excluding airport run) for guests of BISP and Boat Lagoon Resort Hotel.

There are several options now available as a result of this restructuring:

- → If you have not already applied you can now do so by <u>clicking here for new registrations</u>. <u>Please</u> register before May 29th and make payment by June 12th
- → If you have previously applied and paid the initial conference fee, we would hope that you wish to continue with the new look conference at BISP. <u>Unless we hear to the contrary by April 27th</u>, FOBISIA will automatically refund your school the difference between the two conference fees.
- → If you no longer wish to take part in the new look conference, <u>please email Lynne Daniel by April</u> <u>27th (events@bisphuket.ac.th</u>) and we will fully refund the conference fee already paid.
- → Please note that given the relatively low price of the conference fee it is <u>not now possible to offer</u> <u>early bird discounts</u>
