

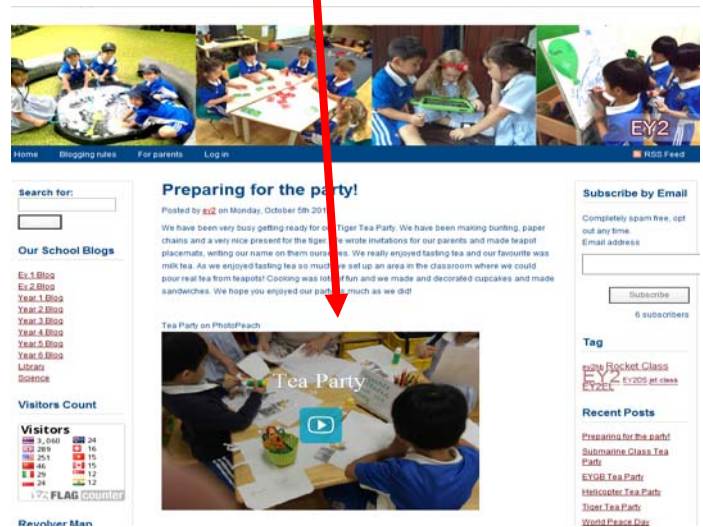
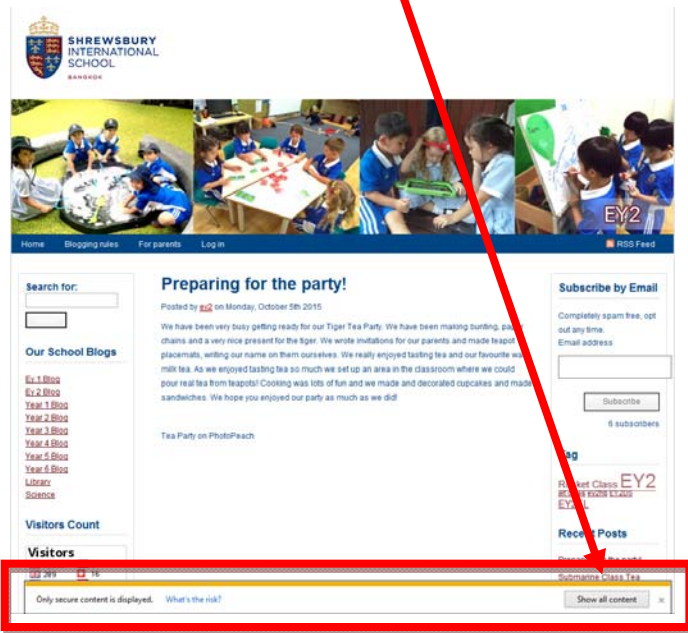
Problems with photographs not showing on the blogs

Using an iPad or iOS device?

Unfortunately you will only see a black outline where the photo slideshow would be. This has always been the case as Apple do not allow Flash to run on their devices. Please use a PC/Laptop or Macbook to view these blog entries.

Using Internet Explorer?

When you arrive at the blog site, you should see a screen like this. You will notice that where the photo should be is now just a plain white space. At the bottom of the page, there is a pop up stating that "Only Secure Content is displayed". Click on "Show all content". The page will reload and the photos should appear. You will need to do this each time you visit the blog.

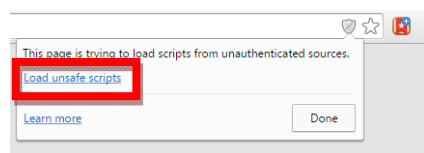


Using Google Chrome?

Google Chrome works in the same way in that it will not allow the flash content to run without asking you first. However, where you click to give it permission to display the content is in a very different place. Look in the address bar and you will see a grey shield on the right hand side.



Once you have clicked on it, a pop up window appears which looks like this. You now need to click on "Load unsafe scripts". The page will now reload and you will see the photos.



Using Opera?

Like the other browsers, they have also blocked flash content. To unblock it, please click on this symbol in the top right hand side of the address bar. Once it has been clicked, click on the unblock button in the pop up box. The page will reload and the content will be shown.
