

Year 11: Geography Mock Examinations 2015

>>>**Equipment to bring to the examinations:** pen (blue or black), pencil, eraser, ruler, 360° protractor and calculator.

The Examinations: There are 3 examinations:

- **Paper 1:** 1 hour 15 minutes. Answer 2 out of 3 questions. This paper will test your knowledge of the topics.
It is important to choose the two questions that will give you the most marks. Therefore read through all the questions carefully before deciding which ones to answer (spend at least 5 minutes doing this). Look at the last part of each question, as this part awards 7 marks and will require knowledge of a case study. Spend approximately 35 minutes on each question.
- **Paper 2:** 1 hour. Answer all 3 questions. This paper will test your skills.
The first question will be a map question, so it is important to revise the map skills you have picked up. The other questions will test your graph-reading, data response and photograph interpretation skills. Some basic knowledge of the topics will also be needed for this paper as there will be some short-answer questions on the topics studied. Spend approximately 15 minutes on each question.
- **Paper 4:** 1 hour. Answer 1 out of 2 questions. This paper will test you on fieldwork techniques.
It is important to re-read your fieldwork notes on river measurement techniques, settlement (city and village) studies and the work on infiltration rates.
